

## Organizers of the largest Exhibition for the Decorators Industry in Germany "Farbe – Ausbau & Fassade 2007" evade Discussion on "Paint Stripping"

Professional decorators experience the highest number of incidents with dichloromethane (DCM) paint removers, yet the organizers of the 2007 event were not interested in hosting a presentation on this topic by our German EASCR member, Scheidel GmbH & Co KG offering DCM-free alternatives since 1984.

We consider this interesting behaviour, especially when one bears in mind that the British consultancy RPA conducted a survey in April 2007 on dichloromethane (DCM) paint stripping, at the request of the EU Commission, and concluded:

- ...to date, a single professional user of DCM-based paint stripper, who monitors the airborne concentration of DCM during use has not been identified.
- ..it has emerged that users have limited knowledge of the role and importance of OELs (occupational exposure limits) and may have limited knowledge on how to assess the risks from the substance...
- ...inappropriate and inconsistent use of PPE (personal protection equipment) is also an issue
- ...around 30.000 decorators (in Germany alone)...companies frequently do not have knowledge or means to adequately protect their employees..
